Free school meals for bubble closures or authorised periods of self-isolation

Dear Parents/Carers,

Today I write to you with some information regarding procedures for receiving packed lunches for those children eligible for free school meals. In order to support our families, we will be able to offer weekly packed lunch hampers to those eligible.

If your child's bubble has had to isolate and been sent home by school; or has been identified by track and trace as needing to isolate due to close contact with someone who has tested positive for coronavirus; or is in self-isolation because someone in the household has shown symptoms of coronavirus and is awaiting a test result, and is already eligible for free school meals, then you will be able to collect a weekly packed lunch hamper from the school for that period of time.

The lunches will be available to collect from the school on a Monday, during selected time slots, for the entirety of the isolation period. If your whole household is isolating and unable to collect the lunch, please arrange for someone else to collect as we will be unable to deliver.
