- Research Pocahontas, who is she? What did she do? Create a fact file.

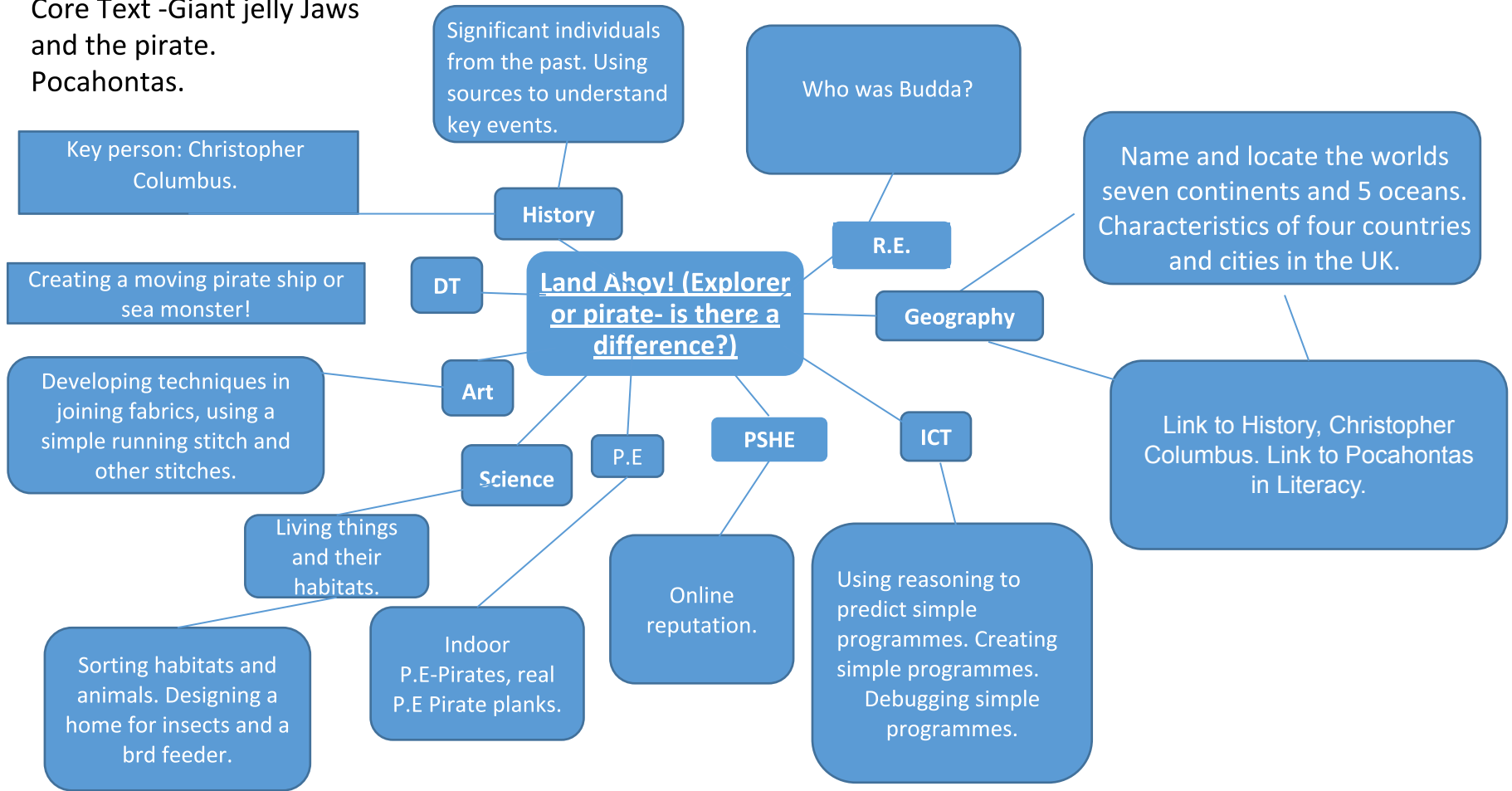
